## Word Storm

Given only the title of the article or reading passage, list as many words as you can think of that may appear in the passage.

Try to propose a word related to the title of the article for each letter of the alphabet. You may include more than one proposed word for any letter. You may leave a box empty if you can't think of any possible words. Standard articles such as "a" and "the" are not allowed.

You will have two minutes to brainstorm words and record them in the boxes on the word storm sheet.

As the groups finish the two-minute brainstorming, distribute copies of the article and highlighters from the envelope to each group member.

As you read the passage, any time one of your proposed words appears in the article, highlight it. When you finish reading, you may review the article to make sure you haven't missed any words. Count the total number of highlighted words to determine your "score."
