





- Discussion of side effects associated with vaccination







How do we process information about COVID-19?


- Get data from trusted sources
 - HudsonAlpha hudsonalpha.org/dei/covid19-resources
 - CDC cdc.gov
 - ADPH alabamapublichealth.gov
 - FDA fda.gov
- Do your own data-driven research
- Consider the pros and cons of vaccination for you and your family
- Consider your impact on those in your community
- Consider your risk level and that of those with whom you gather

Who has already been vaccinated (race)?






Who is currently eligible for vaccination?

- As of April 5th, ADPH amended the rules to allow anyone 16yo or older to be vaccinated.
- Pfizer vaccines have an EUA (emergency use authorization) for 16yo+
- Moderna and J&J vaccines are approved for 18yo+
- It is recommended that those who have recovered from COVID-19 still get vaccinated.




Where can I get vaccinated?



CDC guidance regarding fully vaccinated individuals

- Fully vaccinated person = a person ≥ 2wks post-final vaccine administration
- Fully vaccinated people may now:
 - Visit with other fully vaccinated people indoors without wearing masks or physical distancing
 - Visit with unvaccinated people from a single household who are at low risk for severe COVID-19 disease indoors without wearing masks or physical distancing
 - Refrain from quarantine and testing following a known exposure if asymptomatic
 - Resume domestic travel without pre- and post-travel testing



CDC guidance regarding fully vaccinated individuals

- Fully vaccinated people should continue to:
 - Wear well-fitting masks, practice physical distancing, and adhere to other prevention measures when:
 - in public
 - visiting with unvaccinated people at increased risk for severe COVID-19 disease or who have an unvaccinated household member who is at increased risk for severe COVID-19 disease
 - visiting with unvaccinated people from multiple households
 - Avoid medium- and large-sized in-person gatherings
 - Get tested if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms
 - Stay home when you are sick



What is going on with the Johnson & Johnson Vaccine?

- Use of the J&J (Janssen) vaccine was paused on April 13th after 6 deaths were reported due to blood clots.
- At that time, more than 6.8 million doses of the vaccine had been administered.
- On the evening of Friday, April 23rd, after a safety review, the CDC and FDA announced that use of the J&J COVID-19 vaccine can be resumed in adults 18yo and older.
- Safety information for providers and patients was revised.






