- Discussion of side effects associated with vaccination





# How do we process information about COVID-19?



- Get data from trusted sources

# Who has already been vaccinated (age)?




# Who has already been vaccinated (race)?



# Who is currently eligible for vaccination?

- As of April 5<sup>th</sup>, ADPH amended the rules to allow anyone 16yo or older to be vaccinated.
- Pfizer vaccines have an EUA (emergency use authorization) for 16yo+
- Moderna and J&J vaccines are approved for 18yo+
- It is recommended that those who have recovered from COVID-19 still get vaccinated.



# CDC guidance regarding fully vaccinated individuals

- Fully vaccinated person = a person  $\geq$  2wks post-final vaccine administration
- Fully vaccinated people may now:
  - Visit with other fully vaccinated people indoors without wearing masks or physical distancing
  - Visit with unvaccinated people from a single household who are at low risk for severe COVID-19 disease indoors without wearing masks or physical distancing
  - Refrain from quarantine and testing following a known exposure if asymptomatic
  - Resume domestic travel without pre- and post-travel testing

**Legend:**

- Fully Vaccinated (Green dot)
- Unvaccinated and low risk (Yellow dot)
- Unvaccinated and high risk (Red dot)
- Single Household (House icon)

**Prevention Measures**

- o Wear a mask
- o Keep 6 feet away from others and avoid crowds
- o Choose well ventilated areas
- o Wash your hands

**Scenarios:**

- Two fully vaccinated households: No prevention measures needed
- One fully vaccinated household and one unvaccinated low risk household: No prevention measures needed
- One fully vaccinated household and one unvaccinated high risk household: Take prevention measures
- One fully vaccinated household and two unvaccinated low risk households: Take prevention measures

# CDC guidance regarding fully vaccinated individuals

- Fully vaccinated people should continue to:
  - **Wear well-fitting masks**, practice **physical distancing**, and adhere to other prevention measures when:
    - in public
    - visiting with unvaccinated people at increased risk for severe COVID-19 disease or who have an unvaccinated household member who is at increased risk for severe COVID-19 disease
    - visiting with unvaccinated people from multiple households
  - **Avoid medium- and large-sized in-person gatherings**
  - Get tested if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms
  - **Stay home when you are sick**



# What is going on with the Johnson & Johnson Vaccine?

- Use of the J&J (Janssen) vaccine was paused on April 13<sup>th</sup> after 6 deaths were reported due to blood clots.
- At that time, more than 6.8 million doses of the vaccine had been administered.
- On the evening of Friday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>, after a safety review, the CDC and FDA announced that use of the J&J COVID-19 vaccine can be resumed in adults 18yo and older.
- Safety information for providers and patients was revised.



